# **Welcome Pack Country Leader**

### Start

Pick the Primary Continent Leader you would like as your coach. Setup a weekly meet or call. Stay in touch through chat or recordings.

From your kick @ss intro pls remove the 'in training to become' part. You are now officially a Country Leader. Example: My name is Abdallah Inusah. I am 30 years old and live in Accra, Ghana, Africa. In the Young World Leader Program I am in training to become a Country Leader for Ghana.

When you are ready for your training then post as well on WhatsApp as our Facebook group: "I have obtained [your role]. I am now starting my Training Preparation Pack so I can prepare myself for training." Depending on availability of seats, visa requirements, funds, camp location and more this process could take a 3 – 12 months. We recommend you start the Training Preparation Pack the moment you get your role. Keep the momentum. Keep moving forward.

## **Daily Actions**

- 1. Follow the important conversations. Do NOT follow unimportant conversations. Always be present to your top 3 priorities. Daily start with priority 1, then 2 then 3. I recommend to have your personal well being among your Priority 1 actions. Your priority 2 could revolve around actions which have to do with your immediate environment. Have workability and empowerment around you. For us at the Young World Leader Training Center our priority 2 revolves around having a powerful space with the leaders who are here. Doing the training programs and managing all practicals of running the center. (food, electricity, water, etc) Priority 3 could revolve around various Young World Leader Program related actions. Be present to what is truly important.
- Daily check the page Sustainable World Project Participating Audience for comments. There might be people who will step up to empower you. Respond to them if you see a comment that tells they choose to empower you. Then send them a friend request. - 3. Daily do your inner work
- 4. Make welcome messages or recordings for new members in the Selection group. If you see a Facebook group member from a new country, then give some extra

- encouragement.
- 5. Keep yourself informed on updates in chapter 4, the daily actions of the Action Pack. When you have time you can also do these daily actions. Specially connecting educational institutes will make a big contribution.

## **Weekly Actions**

- It is your responsibility to empower your Project Leaders who have chosen you. Pls setup a weekly meet or call with your Project Leaders. Stay in touch through chat or recordings.
- 2. Every Friday write an update and post it on our page Sustainable World Project Participating Audience. It is your responsibility to share with the people who have liked our page so they get inspired to contribute. Have this update checked for the first month by your PCL coach before you post. You can take a look at the page and find some examples of Gift Tarupiwa. Here are few ideas, you could write: This past week I have supported 2 new leaders with making a professional profile picture and introduction. I have supported Zaira in . . . I have co-facilitated our weekly session on Saturday. In the session . . . I am preparing for . . . My biggest learning this past week was . . .

At the Young World Leader Training Center . . . [what is going on] We are preparing Young World Leader Empowerment Camp [number] We are reaching out to schools to setup weekly online sessions for their students. [give update on that] - Do add a picture to your post.

### **Step 50 – Creating a life long Paid Position**

Empower people in the Selection group to reach out to their schools, colleges and universities. Keep yourself active on 4.3 of the Action Pack - **COMMENTS ON POSTS WITH HEADING 'A NEW EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTE JOINING'** and keep yourself active on 4.5 of the Action Pack - **PARTICIPATING AUDIENCE STUDENTS** 

This will finally lead to you getting a life long paid position in the Young World Leader Program.

When you work on 4.5 of the Action Pack and you are making the Facebook post, then use the following format.

"A NEW EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTE JOINING - I have claimed the role of [your role]. I am now working on the final step 50, creating a life long paid position for myself.

I have sent Welcome Pack 1 to this institute. [mention name of the institute, city and country] Their students will be invited to join our weekly sessions. They will become a partner in creating a sustainable world; a world that works for ALL people.

If YOU know a school, college or university that would be interested to join the Young World Leader Program, then drop a comment under this post. Comment: "I know an institute. Pls send me Welcome Pack 1 for the Educational Institutes".

Next, one of our leaders will contact you and send you the Welcome Pack 1 for Educational Institutes, which you can send to the institute. This simple way you can make a HUGE contribution to creating a sustainable world; a world that works for ALL people.

If you know another type of organization (NGO, Charitable Foundation, Social Enterprise) that would like to partner with us then lead them to our pinned post.
